From 1911-1929 he participated in the development of the Navy's use of what was then a new communications art. Since 1929, Mr. Jett has been associated with the Federal Communications Commission and its predecessor, the Federal Radio Commission, first as Assistant Chief Engineer; then, since February 1, 1938, as Chief Engineer. On February 15, 1944,

Mr. Jett was appointed Commissioner. Throughout his career with the Navy and the Commission, Mr. Jett has been alert to the ever-increasing usefulness of radio in mobile operations. More recently, with the development of radio equipment for railway and highway services and Mr. Jett's origination of the Citizens' Radio Communication Service, his activities with the Commission have taken on even more significance to American economy and well-being.

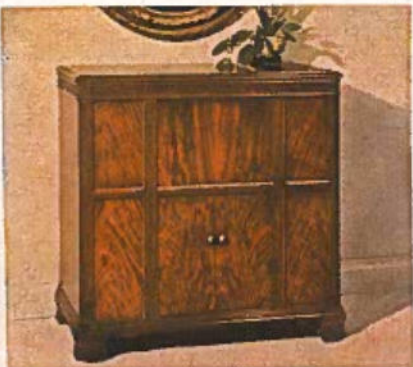
