SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year we award from 12 to 28 scholarships to worthy students of our heritage. They are required to be a member of our Young Adult Network or the child of a member in one of our clubs. Applications for scholarships are available from local clubs or by writing to the Midwest Federation Scholarship Committee.

The funds generated for these scholarships are received during each convention by donations. About eight years ago, the Milwaukee Mens club challenged the President Mr. George Antoon that they would give \$5,000 to a perpetual scholarship fund if he could raise \$20,000. The challenge was accepted and immediately President Antoon received pledges of \$5000 from the Phoenician Club of Chicago, Phoenician Club of Omaha, Joseph R. Shaker Family, Ted & Adele Hazer, Anthony R. Abraham. Since then, the following scholarship donations of \$5,000 or more have been pledged by: Albert & Rosemary Joseph, George & Alvera Antoon, Mr. & Mrs. Marshall Arrieh, in Memory of George Simon, in Memory of Joseph Dumit, in Memory of Thelma Shain, and in Memory of Duke Herro. The most recent pledge received was the Ladies Cedar Club of Flint.

These clubs and families have come forward in the past 8 years to put our perpetual scholarship fund pledges over the \$100,000 mark, and we have received \$56,000 in our general fund. Only the interest each year can be disbursed for scholarships. Our goal is \$500,000 so that we may increase the \$500 scholarships given presently. A confirmation of all donations are acknowledged and all funds are reported by the Federation Treasurer.

Remember, education is our heritage, we are the scholars of the world, therefore we must help future generations attain their utmost in education. Any donation to the general scholarship fund is disbursed each year.
