PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Are you aware —

Your forefathers in the mountains of Lebanon and Syria prepared a code of law, "The Ishtar Code," which they took with them to Egypt and Babylonia from which Hammurabi prepared his own.

Are you aware —

Your forefathers, as emperors of Rome, authorized the jurists, Papenian and Ulpian, to rewrite these laws. (Aemilius Papenianus was born in Homs or Oms and was the author of the principle that all men are equal under the law. Domitius Ulpianus was born in Tyre. Rome was at its greatest under the Syrian "Severous" emperors.) Their work was summarized into the Justinian Code which Napoleon ordered revised and that revision until now is called the Napoleonic Code and constitutes the basic laws of Europe.

Are you aware —

Your forefathers made Tripoli, just north of Beirut, the first area comparable with our District of Columbia and there adopted a constitution to govern the three states of Phoenicia. (Phoenicia included what is now Lebanon, part of Palestine, part of Syria, and part of Turkey and the Aegean Islands.) This constitution was used in Cartage. The founders of this great republic of the United States of America, by the grace of God, of which you are proud citizens, adopted this constitution as our basic law protecting the dignity and the right of men as equal under the law.

Are you aware —

Your forefathers wrote religious books which both the Catholic and Jewish Encyclopedias called "The Books of Canaan" and which the Greek writers called "The Books of Biblos" (the City of Biblos is the present Jebile north of Beirut), or Bible. These books are the words of God and the fabric of our society.

NOW you are aware —

Your forefathers gave the west its laws, its religion and its present civilization which through this federation, you must know, protect and preserve as the greatest trust in your hands.

To succeed you must believe in yourselves and you must believe in your destiny.


