





Lili St. Cyr Saved In Suicide Attempt

LAS VEGAS, Nev., Oct. 31.—Lili St. Cyr, the statuesque stripper, was found unconscious in her hotel bungalow today. Police said she had taken an overdose of sleeping pills.

The 34-year-old night club performer was taken to a hospital, where, after treatment, she was pronounced out of danger.

The police report listed the incident as an attempted suicide brought on by a quarrel with her boy friend, Fred Carson of North Hollywood, Calif.

It was Mr. Carson who found Miss St. Cyr in her bungalow at the hotel where she takes a bath nightly on stage in a strip act.

The stripper is separated from her husband, musician Ted Jordan.

Lili St. Cyr's Hubby Wins Vegas Brawl

Her Husband and South African Social Lion Battle in
Las Vegas—Over Her, of Course

LAS VEGAS, Nev., Aug. 23—The Las Vegas temperature hit 107 today, with an assist from a casino steak house brawl between dancer Lili St. Cyr's husband and another man.

Ringside witnesses said that the husband, Actor Ted Jordan, 33, seemed to have won a close decision from a South African, Derek Goodman, 37, whose name had been linked romantically with Actress Zsa Zsa Gabor.

After the battle on the Strip where Miss St. Cyr, a stripper, is packing 'em in, Jordan refused to comment. Friends said he objected to a remark made at Miss St. Cyr's table.

Miss St. Cyr and Goodman reportedly had been chatting cozily as she ate supper before her last performance when Jordan strolled over to the table.

ROMANTIC TALK

Fellow diners said Goodman, reputed to be wealthy in the manner of all romantic figures, had just told the stripteuse that his romance with Miss Gabor had ended.

"You can't talk about my wife like that," Jordan was heard to say.

Twirling his handlebar mustache, Goodman reportedly said: "Perhaps you're right, but if she was my wife I wouldn't let her out of my sight for 30 minutes as you did."

That did it. While the statuette Miss St. Cyr shrieked and wrung her hands, hubby and Goodman began. Jordan, 15 pounds lighter, tapped Goodman on the jaw. Derek answered with a tackle.

DEPUTIES STEP IN

They wrestled. They rocked and rolled. Fists flew. Miss St. Cyr, often in the publicity spotlight, continues to scream. A chuck wagon was overturned. Two giant urns of chicken soup were spilled.

Clark County deputy sheriffs finally noticed that something was going on. Bravely they waded in. Manfully they halted the tiring "fighters." Goodman disappeared into the dawn's early light. Husband and wife retired to her dressing room.

By June, he and Dorothy were "acting silly," and in August, Dorothy's lawyer said Dorothy wanted out ("a permanent separation") and she was going to sue for a divorce as soon as a property settlement was reached. A wife doesn't get sick of her husband—not to the divorcing point, anyway, just because he plays golf, or eats enchiladas for breakfast. And Mature's crazy about Dorothy's son Mike, whom he adopted. The real reason for their split doesn't appear to have been stated—openly—yet.

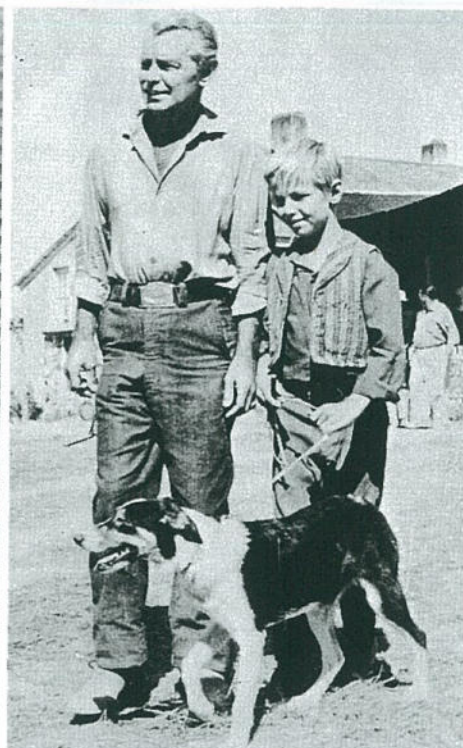

Lili's husband, actor Ted Jordan, 33, took offense at a remark he overheard Goodman make to her.
